Expanded Use of the Hall on Weekends

Recently, the Hall Board approved new rules to allow additional use of the Hall for lodge activities. In the past, our general policy required community support and other committee events to be scheduled on days other than Friday and Saturday nights. These events could be scheduled on Friday or Saturday nights only with special approval of the Hall Board.

Under the new policy, the Odd Fellow committees can use the Hall eight Friday or Saturday nights each year and the Rebekah committees can use the Hall two Friday or Saturday nights each year. The weekend nights may be scheduled if the Hall is available. If other events have been previously scheduled, those events have priority. All of these Hall use requests must be approved by the respective Noble Grand.

The same rules apply to reserving the Hall for these weekend nights. There are forms available on our website that must be completed and submitted to reserve the Hall.

Spontaneous Use of the Hall on Weekends

If neither Hall is reserved for a Friday or Saturday night, it can be reserved for a lodge event at 5pm on the Sunday before the open weekend night. This spontaneous use of the hall does not count against the annual limit described above.

If one of the halls (upper or lower) is reserved for a Friday or Saturday night, the other hall can be reserved starting at 5pm on the Wednesday before the weekend.

The same rules apply to reserving the Hall for this spontaneous use. The forms available on our website must be completed and submitted to reserve the Hall.
